Every Nazarene, wherever he or she is, participates in the wider reality of this vision.

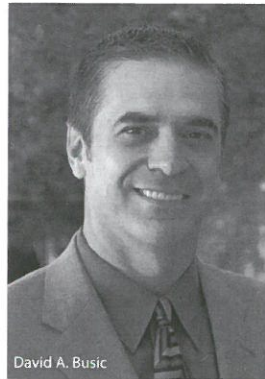
Each transformed life is a testimony to the Wesleyan-Holiness teaching of full salvation for all.

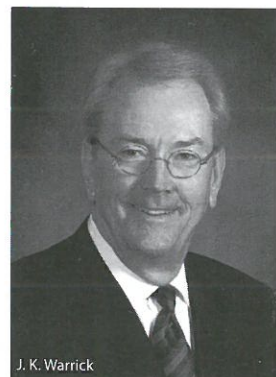
